

Uniform Donor Application

Introduction

The application below is intended for use as a screening tool for anonymous or known (directed) reproductive tissue donors. The goal of the uniform application is to have a comprehensive and consistent manner in which information is collected on all donors. It is also intended to facilitate the donor medical history interview and may help to identify transmissible disease risks which could increase the risk posed to recipients of donated reproductive tissues. This uniform donor application represents a standard for the donor application process. It is acceptable for a clinic to modify based on their clinical practice.
